
2. Prophet

ABOUT OUR CHURCH

Covenant Presbyterian Church began in 1979. In 1985 a small sanctuary was built which now serves as the Covenant Life Center. In 2002 we held the first worship service in our new 12,500 square foot sanctuary which seats 450 people. All facilities are debt free. Our current average attendance is 70-130 (seasonal).

We are located at the main entrance to the Sun 'N Lake subdivision in Sebring, Florida. Our campus includes offices for the pastor, secretary, youth director, choir, conference room, library, cry room for babies and a complete nursery. The Covenant Life Center includes an auditorium/fellowship room, kitchen, restrooms and multiple Sunday School rooms.

ABOUT OUR COMMUNITY

Sebring is the county seat of Highlands County, which is located in the Heartland region of Florida. As of the 2020 census, the population was 101,235. Highlands County is best known for its agriculture, golf courses, lakes, the 12 Hours of Sebring Race, South Florida State College, and is conveniently located less than 80 miles from the Atlantic and Gulf coasts. It is a popular retirement area.
